Who Are Taylors?

Our family established their business in the 1920s, eventually John Taylor would take over the family store and dress makers and by 1948 Taylors became a locksmith and safe engineering business, by the 1970s Taylors worked with the design of the first multi point locking system.

John Taylor and his Sons had established a factory making the first generation of multi point mechanism after seeing them presented by Gretsch-Unitas (GU) in 1979 they presented the GU SECURY multipoint lock with roller cams at the Deubau trade fair (Essen). John understood the early version of these systems from before uPVC even existed, espagnolette and crémone bolt systems were already multi-point fastening tech (rods running up/down the door/window edge, locking at more than one point). Espagnolette hardware has been around since the late 17th / early 18th century, and they are even illustrated in Diderot's Encyclopédie (1771).

What John did was create a design based on Ernst Keller-Volper pattern, it was not the same but inspired a multi point system that he engineered in the UK, but by the mid 1980s Fulex released their first system as the race was on, from Germany to the UK. Who could create the future? John stepped back and moved to aiding in design and testing. He developed the first cap with bypass sections for failed doors. These would later be rolled out in all multi point systems.


We as a business held on to the methods and the tooling. In 1981 we started training the first generation of "Multi Point Locksmiths" a, a term given by John Taylor.

This cemented our future as it meant that we would be the only training provider that could teach the Taylor methods, using the Taylor tooling system that has remained inside our company ever since. By using patents, copyright and trademarks and making sure we hand select our students we have prevented unscrupulous companies from copying our skill sets, methods and tooling.

Today we have advanced this even more with tools that are made by Taylors for our students only and can't be bought or taught by anyone else in the UK or world wide.

Today many companies try to copy our training styles with ourselves being at the forefront of locksmith training.

We don't create just locksmiths, we create Multi Point Forensic Locksmiths the MPFL. The future of locksmithing.

THE MASTER LOCKSMITH PATHWAY

A Structured Route From Training to Professional Competence



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At Taylors Locksmith Training Group, training is not delivered as isolated courses or disconnected skills.

It is delivered as a four-part professional pathway, designed to build competence in the correct order — reducing risk, preventing costly mistakes, and creating long-term stability in the trade.

Each stage builds on the last.
Nothing is skipped.
Nothing is rushed.



Establishing the Correct Starting Point

Every professional route into locksmithing begins with the correct foundation.

The LFA1 (Foundation Award) is the mandatory entry stage required before any hands-on locksmith work takes place. This stage exists to ensure that students understand not just how tools work — but when, why, and whether they should be used at all.

This stage focuses on:




- Core locksmith terminology and principles
- Legal and ethical responsibilities
- Tool awareness and lawful possession
- Professional conduct and expectations

Many locksmith tools are security-restricted. Carrying or using them without legitimate reason or recognised training status can result in serious legal consequences, including charges such as “going equipped”.

Completion of this stage:

- Triggers official training status under the Guild of Master Locksmiths
- Establishes lawful possession and use of tools
- Creates a professional baseline before practical training begins

This foundation stage prevents the most common early mistakes seen in new entrants to the trade and ensures that all further training is built on solid ground.



PART 2: HANDS-ON TECHNICAL TRAINING (LEVEL 3)

Including MPFL-A Forensic Assessment - The 5 day section of the course is a level 3 award. You will then earn your

Level 4 award once you start trading. Its earned over 12 months of trade and can't be bought, only earned.

Where Theory Becomes Real-World Competence

This stage is where locksmithing stops being theoretical and becomes practical, structured, and repeatable. Please NOTE we do NOT teach drilling of locks, we train real technical entry experts not outdated skills.

Hands-on training at Taylors Locksmith Training Group is delivered inside our lock lab using real doors, real locking systems, and real failure scenarios — not simplified rigs or idealised examples. The tools we use are made by Taylors Locksmith Group and only our students can use our tools and methods. These are not taught by any other school in the UK.

Students are trained on:

- Dropped and misaligned door issues
- Failed and jammed mechanisms
- Multi point replacement and servicing
- Snapped and damaged hinges and replacement
- Multi Point Forensic Analysis
- Diagnostic first training (diagnosis before you touch the tools, this prevents future issues for you and the customer)
- Deadlocked multi-point systems
- Failed uPVC door and window entry
- Failed composite door entry - None Destructive
- Obsolete and mixed hardware
- High security cylinder (lock entry (working on today's and future locks, not locks from the 1990s)
- Modern lever lock entry (we don't teach outdated 3 lever lock picking as we don't see 3 lever locks today, however all topics such as this can be found in our online video archive under heritage locksmith skills)
- Auto entry training course, learning to open car door locks the HU66 and HU101 along with decoding and more.
- Safes for residential and commercial use, learning to open them, common faults and more.
- Worst-case access scenarios
- Real doors, real worst case faults
- Real locks, weathered from real jobs
- On your own tool sets, set to you, your hight, strength and ability

These conditions we have created are deliberate and the most extreme case scenarios. If you can work confidently in our lab, real-world jobs become manageable rather than stressful.

Training With Context, Not Guesswork

Many training routes teach isolated techniques without explaining when they should — or should not — be used or outdated methods we used back in the 1980s. Today's locksmith job has vastly changed.

At Taylors, every practical skill is taught in context.


Students learn to:

- Real tool use, hands on on real jigs

MPFL-A — Multi-Point Forensic Locksmith Award

(Exclusive to Taylors)

As part of Level 3 training, candidates complete the Multi-Point Forensic Locksmith Award (MPFL-A) — a specialist forensic assessment framework developed entirely in-house and unavailable anywhere else in the UK.

MPFL-A is not a technique or a tool set in isolation.

It is a closed forensic operating system, designed to remove uncertainty when dealing with failed, deadlocked, or obsolete multi-point locking mechanisms.

MPFL-A training focuses on:

- Forensic assessment with the door shut
- Failure-led diagnosis under load
- Pre-entry risk evaluation
- Pricing confidence and damage reduction

Access to MPFL-A systems, manuals, and tools is restricted to certified candidates only.

A Joined-Up Technical System

Level 3 training is delivered as a connected technical system, not a collection of tricks.

All core locksmith disciplines are taught within real doors and real working conditions, including:

- Residential and commercial door systems
- uPVC, composite, and modern constructions
- Cylinder, mortice, and lever locks
- Multi-point mechanisms and latch systems

Secondary and specialist locking


Modules 1–9 are delivered in full, with continued access to training materials provided via our secure portal to prevent skill fade after training.

These methods were not designed for training environments. They were developed on live jobs, under pressure, across decades of evolving door and lock systems.

Over time, working methods that proved repeatable, reliable, and defensible were refined, documented, and structured.

This process transformed practical experience into:

- Mixed hardware configurations



PART 3: COMPETENCY & FINISHING TRAINING

From Training to Trade-Ready

Hands-on training alone does not make someone a professional locksmith.

The difference between knowledge and competence is consistency — the ability to apply skills correctly, repeatedly, and under real-world conditions.

This stage exists to bridge that gap.

Structured Completion, Not Assumed Ability

After completing the Level 3 hands-on training, students return home and continue through a structured finishing phase delivered via our secure online training portal.

This stage is not time-based — it is competency-based.

Students are required to complete a series of guided assignments designed to:

- Reinforce correct technique
- Identify and correct weaknesses
- Build confidence through repetition
- Confirm understanding of real-world scenarios
- Each submission is reviewed and signed off by a qualified instructor.
- Progress is earned, not assumed.
- Preventing Skill Fade

One of the most common failures of short training courses is skill fade — where techniques learned in a classroom are forgotten or misapplied once training ends.

To prevent this, all core skills remain accessible through:

This environment allows students to train on problems they will actually encounter in the field — not idealised examples.

On-Site Accommodation & Facilities

For residential courses, students stay on-site in modern static accommodation, allowing full focus on training without travel disruption.

The campus includes:

Tools are chosen to:

- Match modern door and lock systems

Students are also taught which tools not to buy — preventing costly mistakes early on.

Starter Stock Package

Students receive a starter stock pack covering the most commonly used locks and components encountered in residential work.

This typically includes:

- Multipoint mechanisms and handles
- Secondary locking components

This allows students to begin trading without immediately tying up capital in stock.. You then reinvest this money from the stock into new stock and expand your stock,
